חקת Chukat — חקת July 5, 2025 – 9 Tammuz, 5785

The first chapter of **Chukat** describes the very strange laws of the Red Cow. The ashes of this cow, together with ashes from cedar wood, hyssop and crimson stuff, are mixed with water to prepare a potion that is used to purify someone who had come in contact with a dead body. Such a person is 'Tameh', unclean, and must wait seven days before entering the Temple. On the third and seventh day,, the priest sprinkles some of this water on the Tameh to make that person 'Tahor', pure/clean.

We are now in the final year of the forty years of wandering in the wilderness. As the Children of Israel approach the bordering nations of the Promised Land, they ask permission to go thru their country, and promise to pay for whatever they use during their passage. The Edomites refuse to let them thru, and so do the Emorites.

Miriam dies at the beginning of the 40th year during the month of Nissan. People cannot find any water and they gather around Moses and Aaron to demand water. Just like when it happened before, they complain that Moses misled them as they would have preferred to have stayed in Egypt where at least they had water.
