**August 19, 2017—27 Av 5777**

In this week's parasha—Re'eh—Moses continues to address the people, and urges them to keep the laws in the new land they are about to enter. Upon settling in the land they will choose a city where they will build a Temple. Offerings of any kind can only be sacrificed in the designated Temple.

This is a very rich Parasha. There is a summary of all the laws of kashrut, the laws of giving tithes to the Levite and the poor, and being generous to the poor, the stranger, the widow and the orphan. There is also a summary of the three pilgrimage festivals.

The Children of Israel are not to learn from the Canaanite people. Tattoos are not allowed and they should not cut themselves for the dead. These were Canaanite practices.

This week's reading concludes with the Mitzvah of being happy on the festivals.

## This Day in Jewish History—27 Av

In 1868, the Ku Klux Klan lynched a Jew, S.A. Bierfield, in Franklin, Tennessee. The KKK was created at the end of the American Civil War, and quickly adopted violent methods, murdering some 1,300 people in 1868. Enemies of the KKK included African Americans, Jews, homosexuals and others, scapegoated to explain the lack of economic success among whites. Even today, the KKK lists among its enemies the Jews, who they believe secretly operate the New World Order.
