Vaetchanan - ואתחנן

August 1, 2020 – 11 Av, 5780

This Shabbat we read the second portion of the Book of Devarim, Moses' farewell address before he dies, and before the people enter the Promised Land.

Vaetchanan means 'I implored'. Moses shared with his people how he implored God to let him enter the Promised Land—to no avail. He will be able to see the land from a distance, as he will go up on a mountain and from there will be able to see the entire country.

Moses emphasizes to the people the uniqueness of God's relationship with them. This was the first time that a people was taken out of slavery and shown God's power. This is also the first time that a people had the opportunity to hear God's voice just like they did at Mount Sinai when they were given the Ten Commandments. In fact, in this Parasha, we find the Ten Commandments once again, as well as the first chapter of the Shemah.

This Shabbat is known as Shabbat Nahamu, for the first word in the Haftarah reading from Isaiah, where he offers words of comfort to the Jewish people following the sadness of Tisha B'Av we just observed last Thursday.
