January 25, 2020—28 Tevet, 5780

Last week's portion ended with Moses complaining to God, "Why did you send me? Ever since I came to Pharaoh to speak in Your name, he has dealt worse with this people, and you have not delivered Your people." (Exodus 5:22-23)

This week's Parasha begins with God telling Moses that the time has come to fulfill the promises made to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob; namely, the end to slavery. That the children of Israel will be **taken out** of Egypt. God will **deliver them**. He will **redeem them** and **make them** His people.

Moses and Aaron are given instructions to warn Pharaoh that terrible plagues will be brought upon the Egyptians if he does not let the people go. Seven of the Ten Plagues are described in this Parasha. Sometimes, Pharaoh promises that he will let them go, but then he changes his mind. The plagues we will read about in this Parasha are: blood, frogs, lice, wild animals, pestilence, boils, and hail.

Pharaoh's heart begins to soften as the plagues take their toll.

On This Day: 28 Tevet



Yahrtzeit of Rabbi David Nieto (1654-1728), leader of the Sephardic community in London. Rabbi Nieto came from Venice and was highly respected as both a rabbi and a medical doctor who wrote extensively on scientific topics. In 1698, Nieto became spiritual leader of the Bevis Marks Synagogue, the oldest Jewish synagogue in London that came to be regarded as the religious center of the Anglo-Jewish world. Today, the original building is still in use, and the synagogue interior retains its original furnishings. In the 1990s the synagogue was badly damaged by terrorist bombings in London; the structure has since been renovated and repaired.
