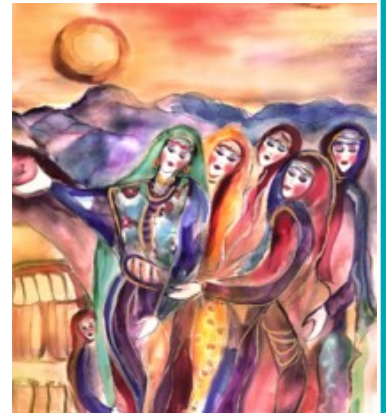

פינחס - Pinhas

July 11, 2020 – 19 Tammuz, 5780

The last story in last week's portion told of Midianite women who had come to the camp of the Israelites. They induced men to commit immoral acts with them and influenced them to worship idols. Zimri, a leader from the tribe of Simeon, brought a Midianite woman in front of Moses and all the people and took her into his tent to perform a sex act. Moses and the Children of Israel were shocked to witness such a failing of all modesty and morality. Pinhas, the grandson of Aaron took a javelin and killed Zimri and the Midianite woman. That act is credited with stopping the plague that had spread in the camp and killed 24,000 men.

Since the people will be entering the Promised Land soon, Moses is told that the land distribution will be made by lottery, with larger portions going to the large families, etc. The daughters of Zelophehad appeared before Moses and the elders, and demanded that they, too, should get land even though there were no sons in this family.
